IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

All students K-8th Grades attending BCCS must submit a copy of their California Immunization Record (Yellow Card or Doctor's Report of Immunization) upon enrollment or re-enrollment.

Personal Belief and/or Religious Exemptions are no longer allowed under the new state laws. However, if you signed an exemption form *before* January 1, 2016 that exemption may remain in effect under certain conditions: If a child is already enrolled at BCCS and had the exemption in effect at the beginning of 1st grade, that exemption will remain in effect until the child enters 7th grade. If a child is enrolled in the preschool and has the exemption in effect, that child may remain in the preschool until the child enters Kindergarten. In other words, the exemption remains in effect until Kindergarten and/or 7th Grade.

Medical Exemptions **are** still allowed when a licensed Physician feels a vaccine is not indicated for a student because of medical reasons. An official State of California Exemption form signed and stamped by a physician must be submitted to BCCS.

BCCS policy states that if a child has not been immunized and there is an outbreak of a vaccinal disease, that child must remain at home until safe to return to school with a return to school form signed by child's doctor.

We understand this is a very controversial issue and we hope that you understand that we are required by law to comply.
